Approval of Minutes

Council Member Hicks made a motion to accept HMB Engineering's recommendation to accept HG Mays Corporation's bid for street paving in the amount of \$78,328.34; Council Member Gallagher seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Vandegrift presented a bid for sidewalk repairs. Council Member Nance made a motion to approve the bid from ADE Contracting, Inc. for \$13,565.00; Council Member Thurman seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 5-0.

Reading of Resolution

Council Member Hicks requested to hear Resolution 2021-004; A Resolution Declaring Certain Property as Surplus Property. Mayor Vandegrift presented the Resolution. Council Member Simoff made a motion to accept; Council Member Nance seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Vandegrift discussed the East Stephens Street trail project. The Council talked about different possible options for sidewalks/trails.
